E-Mail Ballots for Military and Oversea Voters

Active duty uniformed service (and qualifying spouse or dependents) and overseas citizens are permitted to receive the ballot via email request. The voter is still required to print and vote the ballot and return the voted ballot by mail.

If you would like to request to have your absentee ballot emailed to you, you are required to do the following:

STEP 1:

IF YOU HAVE A VIRGINIA DMV ISSUED ID, APPLY ON ELECTIONS.VIRGINIA.GOV.

IF YOU DO NOT HAVE A VIRGINIA DMV ISSUED ID, APPLY FVAP.GOV. THIS APPLICATION WILL NEED TO BE SIGNED AND SENT IN BY MAIL, EMAIL, OR FAX.

STEP 2:

INDICATE EMAIL AS YOUR PREFERRED METHOD TO HAVE YOUR BALLOT.

STEP 3:

FINALLY, MAIL, FAX OR EMAIL, YOUR SIGNED, COMPLETED APPLICATION TO THE VOTER REGISTRAR'S OFFICE IN THE CITY OR COUNTY WHERE YOU ARE REGISTERED TO VOTE.

THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- **MAIL YOUR BALLOT BEFORE THE DEADLINE.**
- **MARK YOUR BALLOT IN BLUE OR BLACK INK.**
- **PO BOXES ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE FORMS OF PERMANENT RESIDENCE.**
